BUILDING UTILIZATION UPDATE



Dear First Church,

A huge thank you to everyone that came out to our meeting about "building utilization" last week. We had 90 people present! I know many others wanted to attend but had conflicts. I am grateful to see such investment in our future as a church, and such willingness to make change as our mission directs.

We started the meeting thinking about First Church in 2054. That's only 30 years from now! If you can easily remember 1994, then 2054 doesn't actually seem that far away. We contemplated, what will First Church be like 30 years from now? Who will be here? What will they need? We talked about all the redevelopment energy in downtown now and more that is coming. We want

to be an essential part of a revitalized downtown. We talked about how we believe God wants churches in downtown, healthy, vital churches that share God's love and speak to people's needs. We are in downtown for a reason, we want to be here!

After that hopeful conversation I shared some sobering facts about our financial situation. Our income from giving has been on a slow but steady downward trend for more than 15 years. Last year 55% of our giving was from people who are age 75 or older. The cost to maintain our building accounted for 32% of our budget last year. In 2009 building cost was only 15% of our budget. With each passing year, our building is taking up more and more of our diminishing resources. It is a trend we have to change. And it will take a major new approach to do so.

In small groups we explored various scenarios for how to increase revenue from the building and/or decrease cost. We talked about sharing the building with other entities that would pay usage fees. We talked about what we would gain or lose if we sold part of the building. We talked about what we would gain or lose if we demolished part of the building.

At the end of the night, I handed out a survey that asked people for comments and to rate from 1 to 5 a general sense of the three major options. On that scale from 1 being disagree to 5 being agree, the results were: Share part of the building 3.24, Sell part of the building 3.15, Demolish part of the building 3.09. I laughed very hard when I saw the averages, we are right in the Methodist middle!

Mostly I take those results to mean that we, as a congregation, are open to all the possibilities for what will best serve the mission of the church now and into the future. I'm so glad for that. Of course, some people lean strongly toward one or another option but as a whole, we are open to whatever path will serve the mission best.

The Leadership Board will continue to explore the options in earnest. I cannot predict what the path will be. But I am praying that God shows us clearly the way forward and removes any obstacles as we try to take the best, most faithful steps. I do promise to keep you, the congregation, well informed as we go forward. We will need more input and, in some scenarios, we will need a charge conference vote before we act.

I know the options can seem daunting; these are not small decisions. The options also bring sadness. So much good ministry has happened in the C and D building and we might long for the days when they were full and bustling. Thinking of how things would look and feel different is scary. I feel all those things right along side you. I also really believe that God has a purpose and a plan for First Church and work for us to do in downtown. I am so glad to be alongside you in this ministry and am waiting with you for what the Spirit will reveal. I trust we will have the courage to act when the time is right.



FLOWER MINISTRY




