

Volunteer in Missions Opportunities in 2025

United Methodist Volunteers in Mission is the short-term mission arm of the United Methodist Church. Our volunteers are lay and clergy, young and old, with differing abilities, vocations, and at different phases in life. We come together through the UMC in order that all may offer their skills and talents for Christian service.

The Great Plains Conference has an active VIM team who participates in projects in Kansas and Nebraska and one in Colorado. Most projects are one week-arriving on Sunday and working through Friday at noon. Many projects sites have places for RV's and all have places for non-RVers. There are no requirements except to have a willing heart to help others. Some people participate in all projects and some only one a year. There is a registration fee for each project. That money goes directly to that project. This money is used to help offset the cost of projects. Most ministries operate on a very tight buget and can hardly afford the projects that need to be done. The 2025 VIM schedule is available below.
